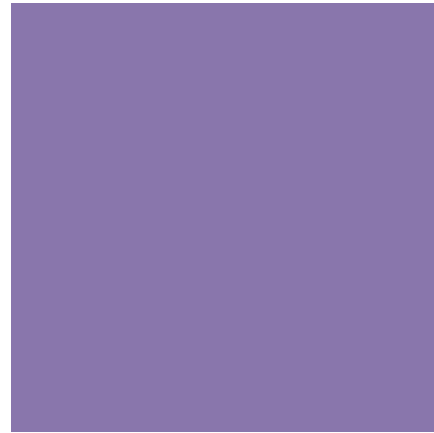

- > **Evaluations**

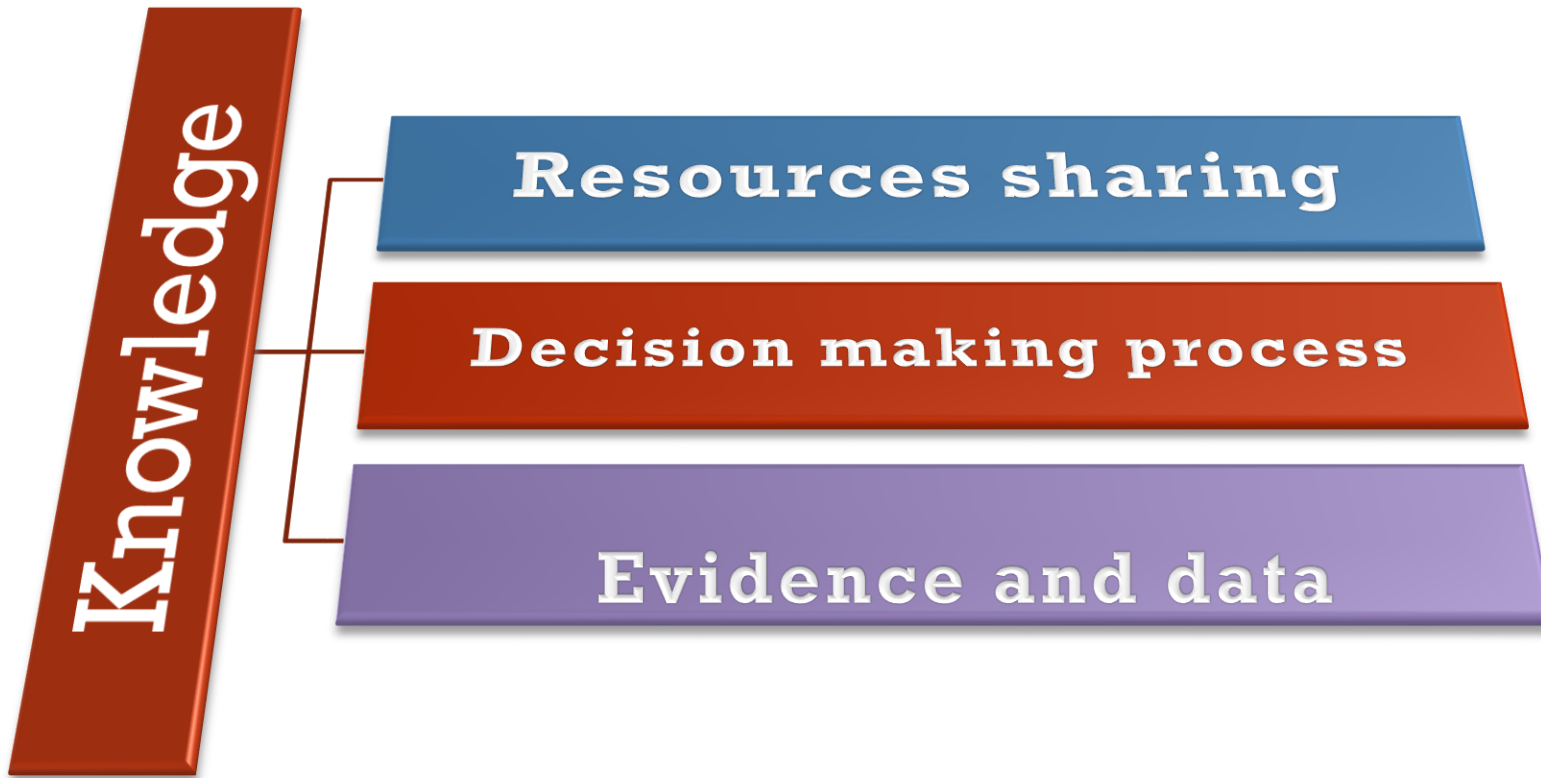
